Waratah-Wynyard Mayor Robby Walsh thanked the community for feedback received so far as part consultation into the draft Wynyard Foreshore Environs Masterplan.

About 140 people provided feedback as part of the first phase of this process, which seeks to formalise the future development potential of the area from the East Wynyard foreshore to Richard Gutteridge Gardens.

“I would like to thank everyone who provided comments into the draft plan and acknowledge the important role you have had in planning for the future of this important area,” Mayor Walsh said.

“Your feedback will now be used in conjunction with further discussions with key stakeholders to develop recommendations and an implementation plan.”

Mayor Walsh said once this process was complete, Council would be reissuing the draft Wynyard Foreshore Environs Masterplan for further public consultation.

“Across the various comments received the most common concerns were regarding a proposal to making a section of Golide Street one way , closing Moore Street onto Goldie Street and the rehabilitation of Camp Creek,” Mayor Walsh said.

“The next designs of the masterplan will therefore resolve all three of these issues, by either dropping them all together such as the one way proposal for Goldie Street, or by looking further at options, such as regarding Camp Creek.”

Other concerns consistently raised included the closure of one of the accesses for vehicles to the Wynyard Wharf, landscaping and streetscaping and a proposed roundabout at Dodgin and Goldie streets.

“Council will now have further discussions with key stakeholders such as the Wynyard Yacht Club, Wynyard Waterfront Motel, the Wharf Hotel, Wynyard Seafoods on the Wharf and others, to help draft the next designs for further consultation,” Mayor Walsh said.
