Waratah-Wynyard Mayor Robby Walsh today called for input into the Draft Sisters Beach Open Space Plan.

Council has made a number of changes to the initial plan following public feedback.

“These changes hopefully not only address some of the concerns raised, but also allow us to take a more strategic approach to delivering on the proposals in the plan in line with the future aspirations of the Sisters Beach community,” Mayor Walsh said.

“It is essential that we get this process right and therefore we hope that this final round of consultation ensures that the community is comfortable with Council’s approach.”

Council will be holding an information session at the Sisters Beach General Store on Saturday 30 May 2015 from 10am until 12 noon to provide more details on the plan.

“Council officers will also be meeting with the Sisters Beach Community Association to provide further details,” Mayor Walsh said.
