



POLITICAL ADVERTISING SIGNAGE

The Waratah-Wynyard Interim Planning Scheme 2013, provides that a planning permit is not required for political advertising signs provided they meet the requirements listed under clause E7.4.

Such signs are exempt if they:

- Don't exceed one and a half metres square in area;
- No such sign shall be an animated or an illuminated sign; and
- Are displayed for the period between the issue of a writ for an election and two weeks after the election.

Further, advertising signs must not:

- Be erected in the road reserve;
- Create a traffic hazard;
- Create loss of sunlight;
- Cause a reduction of visual amenity within the area; or
- Diminish in any way the visibility or effectiveness of any information, direction, safety, warning, traffic control or other like sign of Council or other statutory authority.
