

How do I get a copy of my child's (or my own) immunisation records?

- Complete and lodge this form with Council – a printout of the immunisation record in Council's electronic database will be provided. *If 18 years of age the request needs to be made by that person.*
- As the school immunisation program for Waratah-Wynyard Council has been conducted by Burnie City Council since 2014, a request should also be lodged with the Burnie City Council offices.
- **For all children born since 1996** immunisation records are available from the Australian Childhood Immunisation Register.
